## How Many Are There?

You can support your child's counting skills by helping him or her to understand what is meant by 'How many are there?'

This week, why not play 'Counting trays' with your child?

Use paper plates for this activity. Write a number on each plate, starting with 1, 2 and 3 (then adding larger numbers as he or she progresses).

Provide a pile of dried pasta, bricks or small toys and show your child how to count the appropriate number onto each plate before he or she has a try. You can underline 6 and 9 to avoid confusion.
