Perhaps we can all be inspired by the story of Eric Liddell. Eric was the fastest runner in Britain, winning race after race. The nation couldn't wait to see him take on the world in the 1924 Paris Olympics. He trained hard for his very best event, the 100-meter sprint, in which he was expected to win a gold medal.

Eric's main goal, however, was to serve and follow God, no matter what the cost. Eric withdrew from the Olympic 100-meter race when he discovered that the time trials would be held on a Sunday. The Olympic committee agreed to allow Eric to compete in two other events, which did not take place on a Sunday and though he faced tough competition Eric surprised the world with a gold medal win and new world record in the 400 and a Bronze in the 200.



Eric never gave up and stood by his values. This is a fine example for us all to follow!
