Thurs 9th Jan 2014, 9.30am

Please remember that you will need to complete an application even if your child attends our Nursery. Applications must be submitted to the Local Authority (Bucks CC) by January 15th 2014.

Please do not park your car on Culpepper Close when you drop off or collect your children. Culpepper Close is the narrow road that runs round the back of the school to the staff car park. Parking on Culpepper Close prevents our neighbours from using their parking spaces. Also, please remember that we do not permit parents to use the staff car park.

Please remember to return your data checking sheet to school as soon as possible – this will save us any time having to chase your return. It is really important to us that we have all the correct contact information for you.
