Tomorrow marks the start of a special month for our Muslim staff and families. During this month Muslims get up very early, before the sun rises, and eat breakfast. They do not eat or drink again until the sun has set and it is dark. It's a long time to go without food or drink, from before dawn until sunset. This time is known as Ramadan, and going without food or drink is known as fasting. It's not easy to fast, so children don't have to until they are older. Everyone else tries to make the effort.

By going without food and drink, Muslims choose to focus on what is important to them; Being faithful to God, reading from the holy book, the Qur'an, speaking to God in prayer, and thinking about friends and families, and those less fortunate than themselves.
