Literacy

- Name recognition and name writing

- Pumpkin Soup-Story retelling, following instructions and writing lists. Focus on writing initial sounds and beginning to segment for spelling
- Reading Books- The children will be taking home reading books and beginning to take home 'set words'


Phonics

- Phase 2
- GPC's taught- s, a, t, p, l, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u,r, h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss
- Tricky words- to, the, no, go , I
- Oral blending and segmenting-initial sounds, VC an CVC words

Mathematics

- Numbers to 5- counting to 1, 2, 3, counting 4 and counting to 5
- Sorting- sorting into 2 groups
- Learning to subitise to 5
- Comparing groups within 5 comparing quantities of identical objects and non identical objects

Key Language: Hungarian number frame, counting, numicon, beads, counters, sorting, groups
